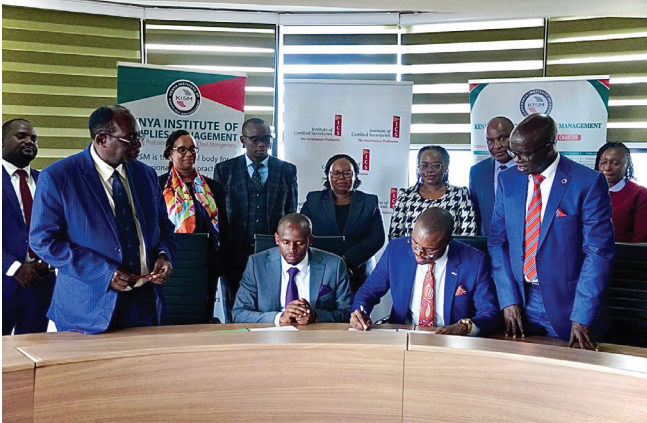
## CEO assumes office and holds his 1<sup>st</sup> staff meeting

# OPERATIONALIZATION OF THE KENYA COLLEGE OF SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT (KCSCM)

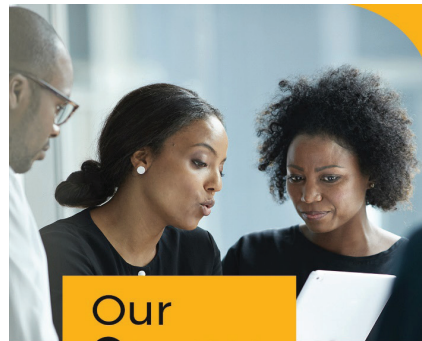

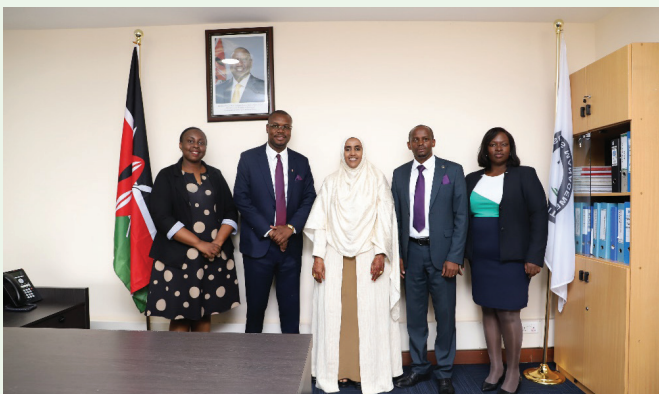

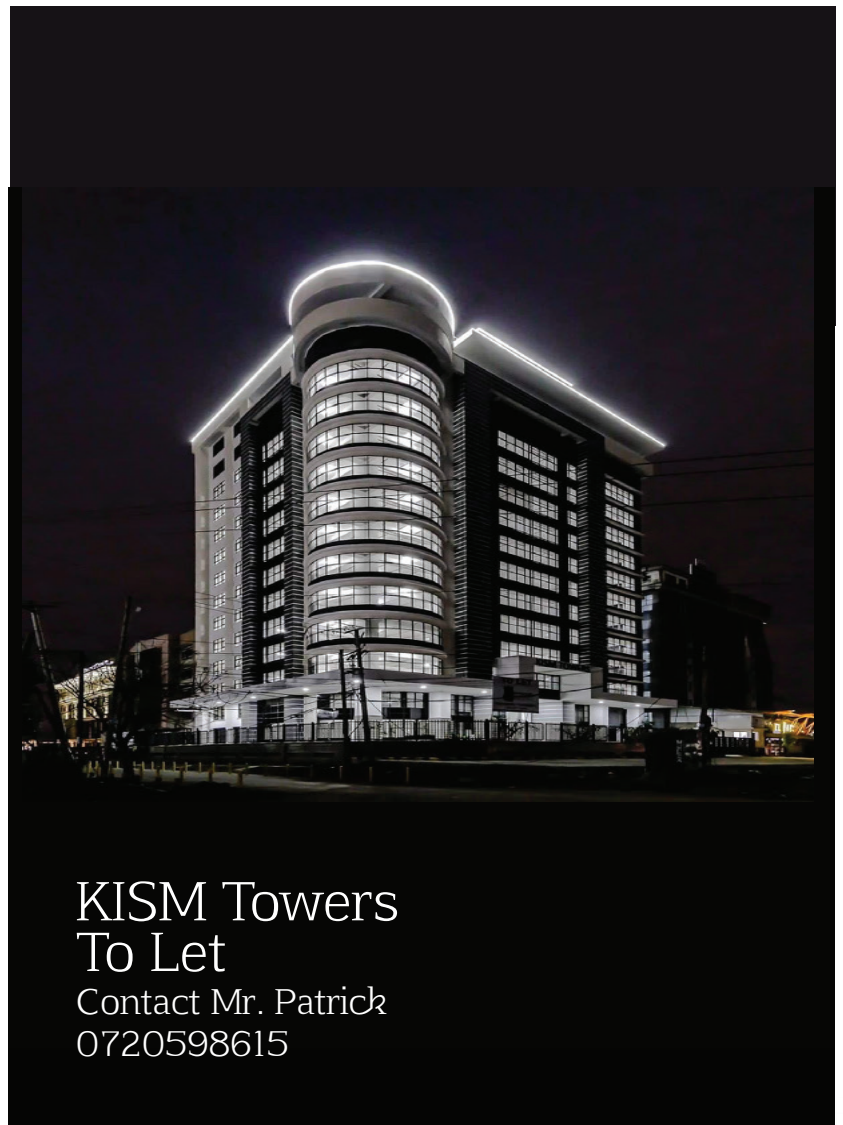
