- Post-graduate professional qualification in procurement and supply, or in the respective field for other areas of practice.
- Registration as a member of KISM in good standing, or membership in another relevant professional body for other disciplines.
- Holders of KISM Supplies Practitioners License for SCM discipline.
- Holders of Certified Procurement and Supply Chain Professional of Kenya (CPSK) Qualification will be given preference.
- A minimum of ten (10) years of practical experience in procurement and supply chain or in your area of professional practice.
- A minimum of two (2) years' experience in training and capacity building in SCM.
- Proficiency in MS Office applications.
- Fluent in both written and spoken English.
- Previous teaching/training experience will be considered an advantage.

2. Chartered Institute of Procurement and Supply (CIPS)

Ideal candidates should possess the following minimum qualifications:

- A first degree in a relevant field in Supply Chain Management, Candidates holding a Master's degree or Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) will be given preference.
- Post-graduate professional qualification in procurement and supply, or in the respective field for other areas of practice.
- Registration as a member of KISM in good standing, or membership in another relevant professional body for other disciplines.
- Holders of KISM Supplies Practitioners License for SCM discipline.
- Holders of Certified Procurement and Supply Chain Professional of Kenya (CPSK) Qualification and CIPS will be given preference.
- A minimum of ten (10) years of practical experience in procurement and supply chain or in your

area of professional practice.

- A minimum of five (5) years' experience in training and capacity building in SCM.
- Proficiency in MS Office applications.
- Fluent in both written and spoken English.
- Previous teaching/training experience will be considered an advantage.
