Mr. Karani addressed the key challenges in inter-agency synergy building, including; Communication Barriers - Misunderstandings due to jargon, or technical language in each field; Conflict Resolution - Addressing conflicting viewpoints or priorities, and Coordination: Aligning timelines, tasks, and responsibilities across diverse disciplines.

The Chairman also addressed strategies for successful collaboration including: Clear Communication - Establishing shared lan-

guage and expectations, Building Trust: Encouraging openness and respect for different perspectives, and Leadership Support: Facilitating collaboration through guidance and resources.

INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE FOR PROFESSIONALS CONVENED BY KASNEB

KISM CEO Mr. Kenneth Matiba addressed attendees at the KASNEB International Conference in Mombasa, focusing on the future of Kenya's Electronic Government Procurement (e-GP) system. He acknowledged the system's role in improving efficiency, transparency, and accountability in public spending but highlighted persistent challenges in system stability, digital literacy, and cybersecurity.

Matiba expressed optimism about e-GP's potential to revolutionize Kenya's procurement landscape. He emphasized the need for a comprehensive e-GP strategy aligned with national development goals, coupled with investments in infrastructure and human capital. Promoting collaboration, knowledge sharing, and continuous system evaluation were also highlighted as crucial steps.

By prioritizing these areas, Matiba asserted, Kenya can establish itself as an African leader in e-GP and deliver substantial benefits to its citizens.

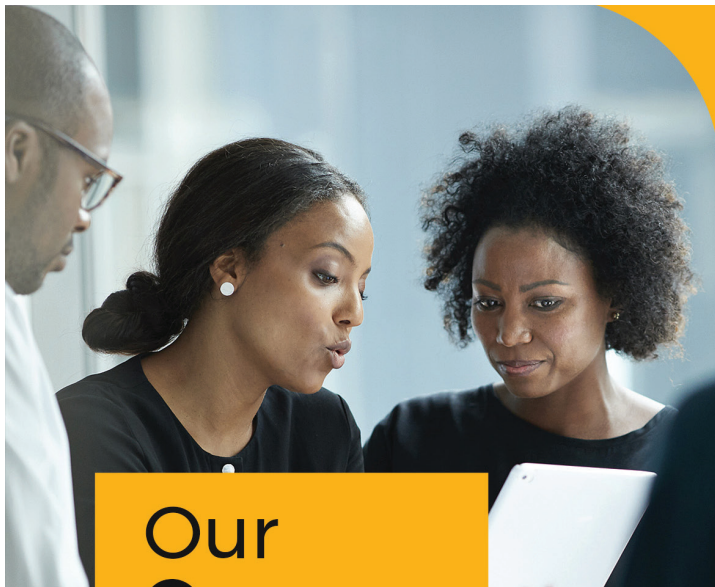

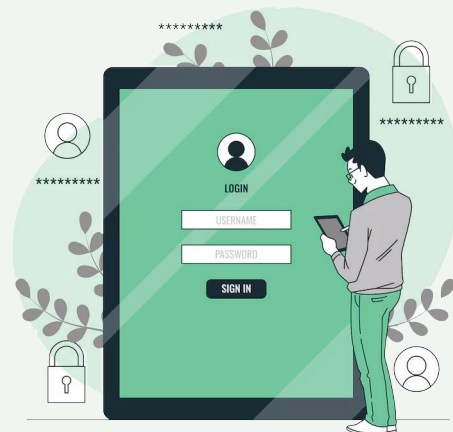

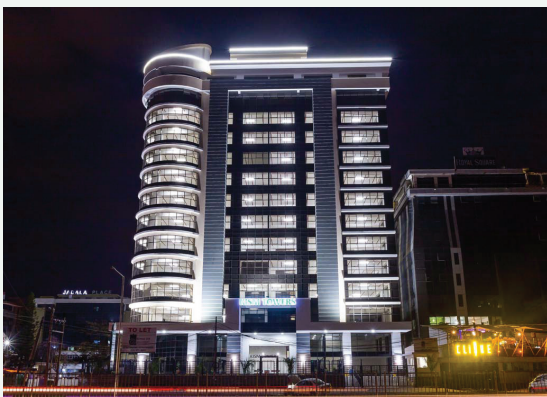
