WORKSHOP ON APPLICATION OF MODERN TECHNOLOGY IN SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT

The Institute convened the first supply chain technology-focused workshop, Application of Modern Technology in Supply Chain Management: Leveraging Artificial Intelligence and Blockchain Techniques on 2nd – 6th September 2024, at Lake Naivasha Resort. The Institute organized the workshop against the backdrop of technology's role in global, regional, and national economic and social transformation, emphasizing its significance in supply chain management by providing revolutionary advantages that enhance productivity, visibility, and flexibility

The workshop aimed at fostering innovation; equipping supply chain and procurement professionals with the skills and knowl-

edge needed to thrive in the digital age; promoting collaboration between the public and private sectors to drive technology adoption and innovation; enhancing efficiency and discuss strategies for overcoming challenges hindering adoption of technology.



The workshop attracted over forty participants from various sectors, including state corporations, counties, non-governmental organizations, and technical institutions. Participants engaged in discussions on a range of topics, such as big data and analytics, strategies for successful digitization, identifying counterfeit products using technology, electronic government procurement, technology-driven resilience strategies, and the application of artificial intelligence.

A recent assessment revealed that the adoption of technology

in supply chain management was lagging behind in numerous organizations. Key challenges identified included a shortage of technology skills among professionals, misconceptions about the benefits of digitization, the substantial costs associated with technology investments, and a lack of support from management.

To address these issues, it was recommended that the Institute provide ongoing training to educate supply chain practitioners about the advantages of embracing technology. Organizations were advised to start with small-scale technological changes and gradually expand their use based on their specific requirements.




Additionally, KISM was urged to recommend that the government invest in technology startups and foster innovation. The govern-

ment was also called upon to establish standardized guidelines for software applications.

The workshop was attended by leading figures in the field, including Mr. John Karani, MBS, the Chairman and Mr. Kenneth Matiba, the CEO. The workshop facilitators were comprised of chief executives from prominent technology organizations, technology experts from academic institutions, and representatives from the National Treasury.



NOTICE ON COMPLIANCE CHECKS

The Institute has commenced compliance checks within Procuring Entities to enforce compliance by all Practitioners. This exercise is aligned to execution of its mandate which includes monitoring the standards of the supplies chain management profession, and enforcing compliance as may be necessary to maintain a proper standard of conduct among supply chain management practitioners.

So far, 21 officers in 4 institutions have been found practicing without the requisite licensure and registration to practice and shall be taking the next steps as provided for in the Law.

We urge all supply chain management practitioners to ensure compliance with the provisions of the Supplies Practitioners Management Act, 2007 relating to membership and licensing requirements to remain in good standing. It should be noted that,

"Section 32 (1) states that, "Any employer who employs an unregistered or unlicensed person as a Supply Chain Management practitioner shall be guilty of an offence and is liable upon conviction to a fine not exceeding five hundred thousand shillings or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three (3) years or to both".

(2) Where the employer provided in subsection (1) is a body corporate, the Chief Executive Officer of that corporation shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to the penalties provided in subsection (1)."


