NOTIFICATION OF THE INTENTION TO GAZETTE ALL LICENSED SUPPLIES MANAGEMENT PRACTITIONERS BY 10TH AUGUST 2026 IN LINE WITH THE SUPPLIES PRACTITIONERS' MANAGEMENT ACT (2007) AND SUPPLIES PRACTITIONERS MANAGEMENT (REGISTRATION & LICENSING) REGULATIONS (2015)

Dear Esteemed Members,

The Kenya Institute of Supplies Management (KISM) is established under **Section 3 of the Supplies Practitioners Management Act, 2007 (SPMA)**, with the mandate to register and license all supplies practitioners in Kenya and to regulate the practice of the supply chain management profession.

Pursuant to sections 16, 20, and 21 of the SPMA and Regulation 27(1) & (2) of the Supplies Practitioners Management (Registration and Licensing) Regulations, 2015, the Notice of Intention to Gazette All Licensed Supply Chain Management Practitioners for the Year 2026 is hereby issued.

The publication of the details of all licensed practitioners in the Gazette shall be *prima facie* evidence that the persons named therein are licensed and authorized to practice.

This notification is directed towards all Supplies Practitioners operating in all sectors across the Republic of Kenya including the Private Sector, NGOs, and the Public Sector (both national and county governments). Relevant professionals include, but are not limited to, Supply Chain Management Officers, Procurement Officers, Managers, Procurement Directors, Warehousing/Stores Officers, Logistics Officers, Lecturers, SCM Investigators, and Consultants.

The Gazette Notice will be published on **Monday, 10th August 2026**, and will include the full list of licensed practitioners as at
